GET SET FOR WORK

Through VPG's Get Set for Work program participants can access activities that help prepare them to reconnect with school, get a job or continue with further training.

Participants will receive career guidance and support to help determine and find appropriate career pathways.

All activities are designed to improve community connectedness and will include guest speakers, mentors and industry visits.

Get Set for Work is for young people aged 15-19 who:

- have left school early
- are 'at risk' of leaving school early
- are unsure of where to go next

Get Set for Work offers participants personal development and team-building activities to help them learn the social skills necessary in the workforce/training setting.

Activities can include:

- Life skills and positive personal behaviours
- Accredited vocational education and training
- Job preparation assistance
- Work experience opportunities
- Referrals and links to support services
- Literacy/Numeracy assistance
- Personal support and follow up
